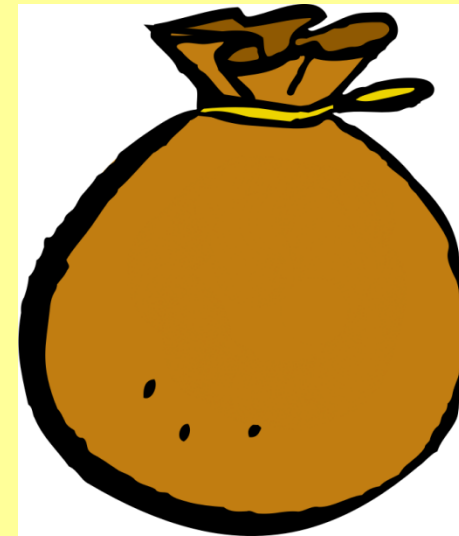
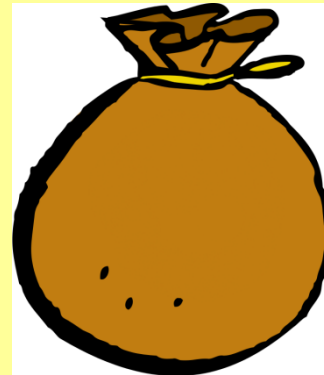
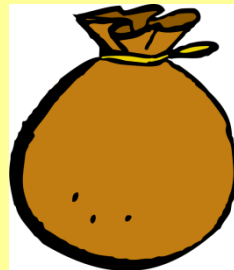
If you can't listen to this, listen to a song on the radio or another music player instead; answer the same questions.

He could then pay any sum of money from 1p to 15p, without opening any bag.

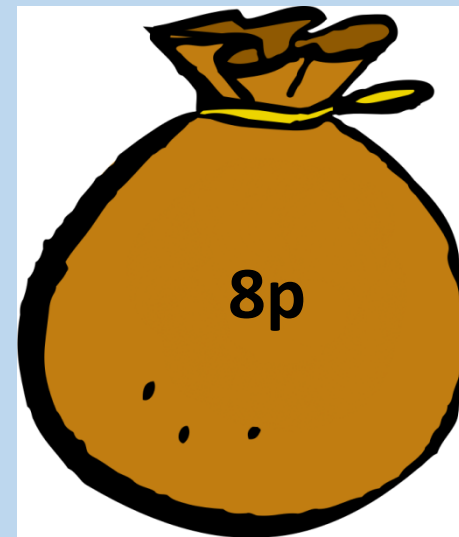
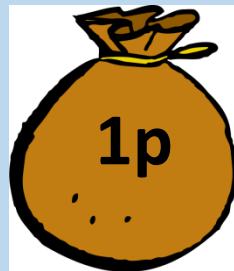
How many pennies did Ram put in each bag?

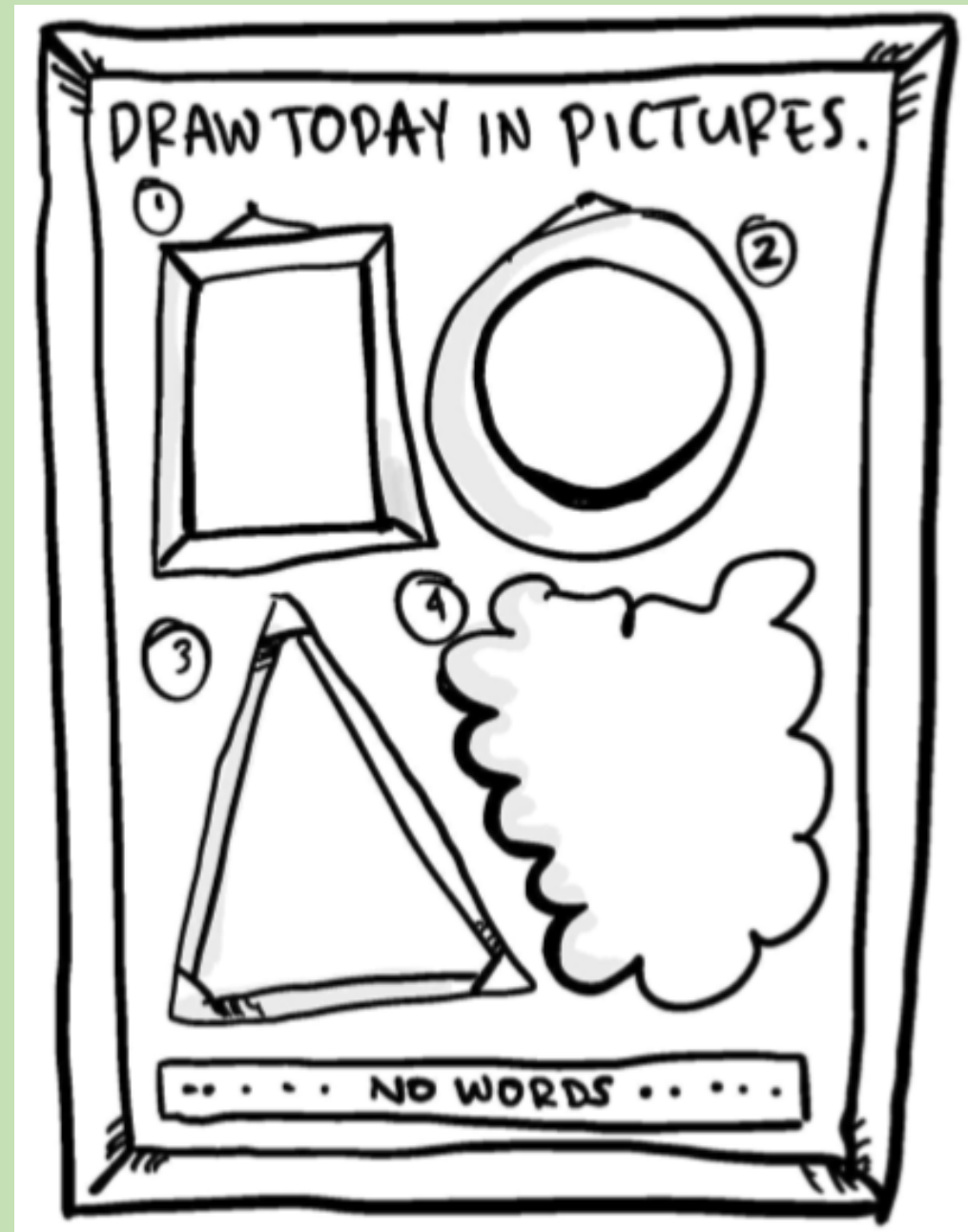


The answers are on the next slide!
