Here are your activities for this week, we hope that you enjoy them! We are looking forward to seeing what you have achieved this week.


Maths



Finding Quarters


Shade **one quarter** of these shapes.



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



Find two ways to shade **one quarter** of this shape.




Terrific T-Rex

9 The T-Rex was one of the largest and most powerful
16 meat-eating dinosaurs that has ever lived on our
26 planet. Standing up to a huge six metres tall and
36 at up to twelve metres long, the T-Rex moved

51 Their powerful jaws meant that they could eat
61 their prey in one bite. The T-Rex had quite a large

87 America before becoming extinct around sixty-
95 five millions years ago but nobody can agree for
103 sure why all dinosaurs suddenly became extinct

Topic- Science/ Art

This week we are going to continue to look at plants.

Task 1- Parts of a plant

Plants have different parts to them, just like you. We have different body parts such as arms, legs and a mouth. A plant has different parts too and they all do different jobs. Read the PowerPoint to find out about the different parts- '**Parts of a plant**' (Available on the school website). Can you label the parts of a plant? Task 2- Parts of a tree

Task 3- Art

We would like to create leaf rubbings. To create leaf rubbings, follow the instructions below:

1. Collect leaves.
2. Place paper over the leaf.
3. Rub a crayon over the entire leaf.
4. Remove the leaf.

Challenge:
