Have a go at making a balance scale using a coat hanger. An example for how to make one can be found here:

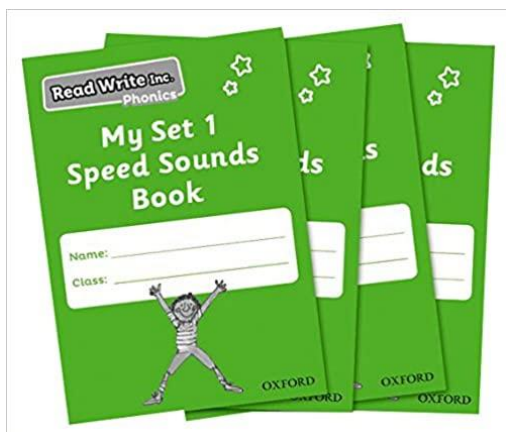
