



<p>Other areas</p>	<p>Chinese New Year is Friday 12th February. We are going to be learning about this at the end of the week but here are some activities that you may wish to do during the week.</p> <p>Research the country of China. What can you find out? Make a poster to tell us all about China.</p> <p>During Chinese New Year celebrations, children are sometimes given envelopes with money inside! With an adult, look at some coins and see if you can see any numbers on them. What numbers can you see? What shape are the coins? What colours are they?</p>  <p>Fireworks are often seen during Chinese New Year. Paint or draw a firework picture. You could use crayons, pens, paint or glitter and glue.</p> 
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Make a model dragon - you could use cardboard tubes and boxes, playdough, construction toys or natural materials like leaves and pebbles. Maybe you could draw a picture or take a photo of your dragon model
