Dear Parents and Carers

Pedestrian Road Safety Training

We have arranged for Pedestrian Road Safety Training (Stepping Out) through Worcestershire County Council, which will take place for children in Year 4 in April and May 2020. The training scheme aims to improve a child's observation and awareness skills while crossing the road and helps them to be more aware of the importance of being visible by drivers.

The training consists of a short classroom session followed by a walk with a trained instructor and volunteer adults. The classroom-based session will cover identifying risks and safe behaviour when out on the road. After the classroom session, pupils will be taken out of school on a short walk around the local area to practise the skills they have learnt – such as stop, look and listen and safer places to cross the road. Part 2 of the training is usually 2 weeks later and the children follow the same route as in Part 1, where they will be observed and marked by the instructor and adults as they walk the route. The children will be under observation by adults throughout the entire route.

Please ensure you complete and return the attached Worcestershire County Council form, as well as completing your permission on Parentpay.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £2 per child towards the cost of this training. Payments must be made via the Parent Pay website. Please complete consent and payment on **Parent Pay by Wednesday 1st April**. School uniform must be worn.

We would like to make it clear that this contribution is entirely voluntary, and there is no obligation for you to submit this payment; however, should we be unable to cover the full cost, insufficient funds may result in the event being unable to go ahead. If we have already received donations prior to the cancellation of the trip, please be assured that these will be refunded to parents in full. We would also like to inform you that, should you decide not to make a contribution, neither you nor your child will be treated any differently from those who have paid, and your child's place on the trip will not be withdrawn as a result of lack of payment. All donations are greatly appreciated and mean that if we can cover the full cost, we will be able to enhance your child's learning in a way that we believe to be most beneficial.
