As the weather begins to warm up and we begin to enjoy the sunshine by the sea and swimming pools, the Royal Life Saving Society have shared some tips for staying safe in and around the water.



 LOOK OUT FOR LIFEGUARDS If you're looking for a place to cool off, always find a lifeguarded swimming site	 IT'S COLDER THAN IT LOOKS Water at open and inland sites is often much colder than it looks. Cold water can affect your ability to swim and self-rescue	 DON'T GO TOO FAR Always swim parallel to the shore, that way you're never too far away from it	 IT'S STRONGER THAN IT LOOKS Currents in the water can be very strong. If you find yourself caught in a current – don't swim against it – you'll tire yourself out. Stay calm, swim with the current and call for help	 BRING A FRIEND Always bring a friend when you go swimming so if anything goes wrong, you've got someone there to help
